2 Day Student Assistance Team Training

The Student Assistance Program Team Training is an intensive, highly experiential training that serves a team of five to eight educators. Educators will be trained in how to identify, intervene with and create appropriate action plans for students who may be at risk for issues such as substance abuse, depression, suicide and violence. The program gives new or established Student Assistance Teams, concrete skills and strategies to begin or enhance the prevention and intervention process. Specific strategies for identification and intervention in the areas of academics, health, behavior, and attendance and participants will leave with a specific plan for behavioral interventions, and a system for implementing a student assistance program in their schools.
